One day Seminar on "Writing Effective Research Papers and Research Proposals" was organized at NIT Graduate School of Management on 24th December, 2022 .The program was aimed to promote research among the faculty members exclusively for the research students who got registered from the year 2021 in all disciplines offered by R.T.M. Nagpur University. Dr. Vaibhav Bhalerao, IQAC Coordinator welcomed all the dignitaries and delegates of the one day seminar. Dr. Mukesh Patil, Director, NIT-GSM delivered the presidential address and briefed about the importance of publication and encouraged all delegates to their active participation. She made the participants comfortable and informing about the basic functions of library management include overseeing all library operations, managing the library budget, planning and negotiating the acquisition of materials, interlibrary loan requests, stacks maintenance, overseeing fee collection, event planning, fundraising, and human resources.

She informed the participants that library software is designed to manage all the functions of a library. It helps librarian to maintain the database of new books and the books that are borrowed by members along with their due dates. This system completely automates all libraries' activities.

In second Session Mrs. Varsha B Patil gave them information about how to use Library Software for issuing books to students, Faculty Members. Further, the Speaker gave them handson training on how to use Library software for generating database for new books, Journals, Research Paper articles, Students data entry, formatting and report generation. The narrator also gave few suggestions on how to have regular backup and save daily library work in case of system crash or any other technical failure.
